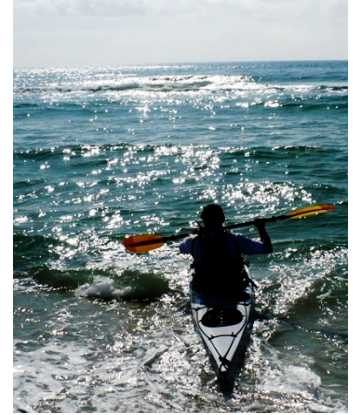

For over 20 years, Outward Bound has run Wilderness expeditions specifically for war veterans. Now, through generous funding from the Sierra Club Foundation, this tremendous opportunity for adventure and self-discovery is at absolutely **NO COST** to OEF/OIF Vets.

The program being offered is on Alabama's Gulf Coast, which offers a flavorful gumbo of untamed wilderness, marine science, American history, fishing villages, and white sandy beaches that join together from both land and sea. Your kayak trip will depart from Weeks Bay National Estuarium, where you will have the opportunity to learn about the Gulf Coast's fragile ecosystems. Your itinerary will include a paddle along the shore of Mobile Bay to the Bon Secour fishing village. Your crew will purchase fresh seafood from the dock to cook along the way. The next few days will be spent paddling through the Bon Secour National Wildlife Refuge featuring pristine bayous, marsh shorelines and pine savannas. The Five Rivers Sea Kayak course is a physically challenging trip that is spiced up with rich cultural opportunities.
